

# Getting Started

## First Time Users

1. Browse over to [kleberglibrary.com](http://kleberglibrary.com) and click on eLearning Resources > LearningExpress Library 3.0
2. Click on the Register button in the upper right-hand corner of the page.
3. Enter your e-mail address (which becomes your user name), create a 6-12 character password, enter your name and hit Create Account.
4. Once you hit Create Account, you will be logged in automatically to LearningExpress Library, where you will have full access to all course material and practice exams.

## Returning Users

1. Browse over to [kleberglibrary.com](http://kleberglibrary.com) and click on eLearning Resources > LearningExpress Library 3.0
2. Click the Login button in the upper right-hand corner of the page, enter your Username and Password, and then click Login.

## How To Select Courses

1. Using the course carousel, browse through the courses to select the ones you wish to practice.
2. Once you have found your category, click on it and its sub-tabs to access materials related to that category.
3. Depending on if you select practice exams or eBooks will determine what you need to do next. Follow all on-screen instructions that appear on the screen.
