KCALC is located in the R. J. Kleberg Public Library in Kingsville, and we provide services in public building within the community.

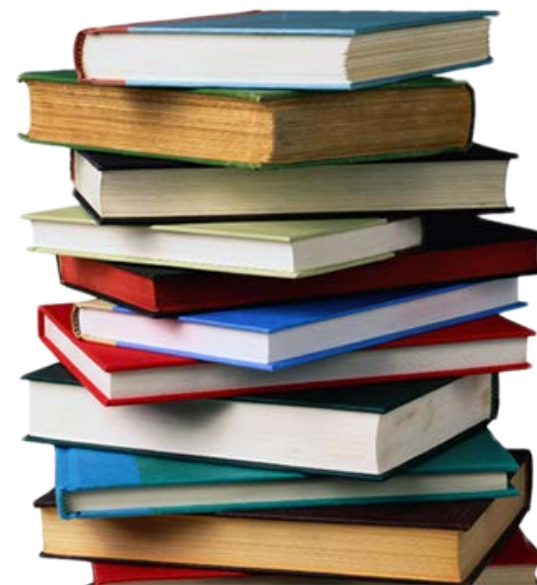
Kenedy County Residents

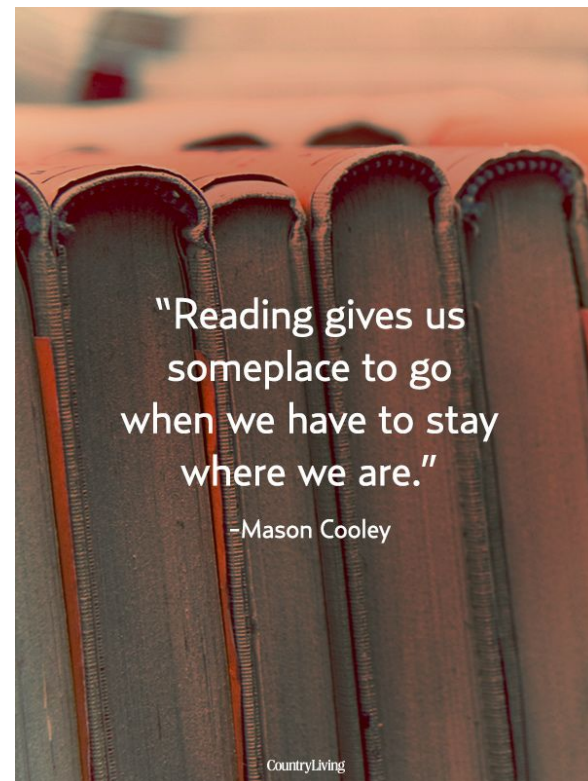
