Mr. Hogan stated he was pleased at how smoothly the project was running. The boilers are installed and solar will be installed next week. Progress checks are being done weekly.

Mr. Bishop sent a project report to Stephanie Masin this AM. The boiler installation is 99% complete. They are waiting for control communication cards. The boiler Inspector is delayed in scheduling his inspection date. The City did fire the boilers today and they are running safely. The hot water heater is 100% completed and controls are 90% completed.and

The Big items HVAC unit 3 & 4 were completed in September. Unit 2 is 90% completed. Unit 1 is at 85% and still needs some ductwork and interconnections between condensing units etc. The humidifiers have not arrived yet. There is a factory delay related to COVID. The estimate is about 3 weeks LED lighting building envelope is 100%.

Rooftop solar installation will start 11/5/20. Waterproofing has become an issue in elevator equipment room. It was not covered under the original scope of the project. ABM has absorbed the cost of the additional waterproofing in the equipment room. Tim Zebel, City Engineer thinks the wastewater drainage system could be a potential cause in the air handler, mechanical room. He does not think they are related. He is working on a solution with City Plumbing. A check valve or back flow preventer in sanitary system could prevent a backup. Manholes were being cleaned that day and could have been a 1 time incident It is not clear where the 4 drains inn the electrical room go so will use a camera in each line to see where the drains lead too. to help ;determine the best solution.

Continued flooding in mechanical room on the north side of the building affects the elevator pit and mechanical room. Doesn't ;appear to be ground water seepage but any be rainwater runoff from the road and is not in ABM's scope of work. Its Plumbing will be scoping out the drain to determine a fix for the problem The boilers have not yet been fired up ad the building got so cold the library closed for a day City pluming will be presenting a Maintenance proposal and an ion system to kill bacteria and viruses.
