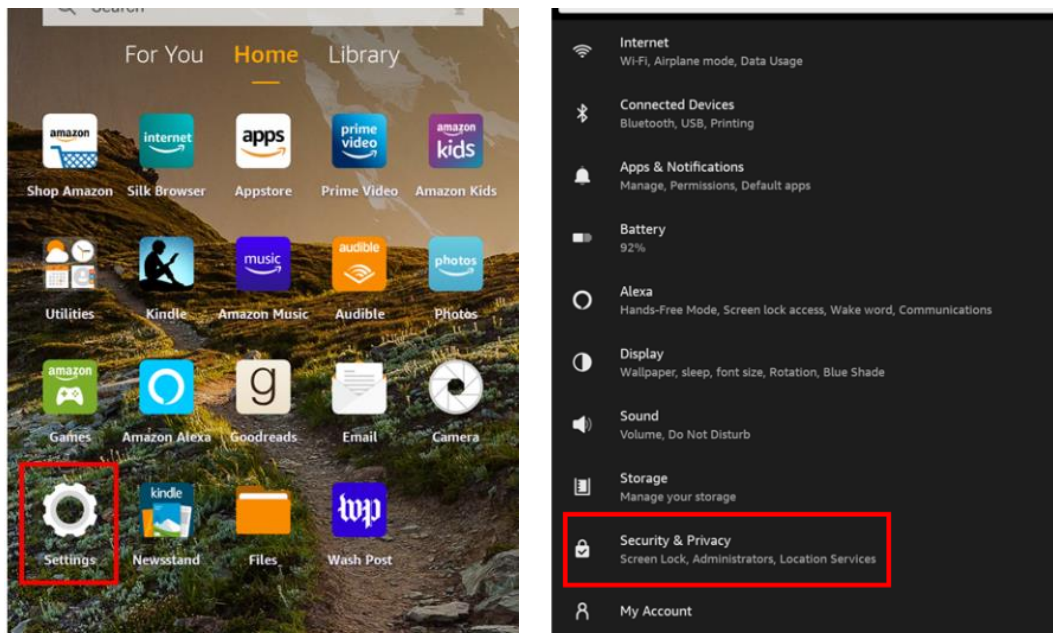


How to Install the Libby App on Your Kindle Fire tablet

The Libby app is not available in the Amazon app store on Kindle Fire devices, but there is a workaround in the following steps below.

1: Prepare Your Fire Tablet

Go to Settings > Security (or Applications) > Enable Apps from Unknown Sources (this will prompt a warning message—that's normal).



2: Open Your Browser

Type <https://apps.goodereader.com/category/android-apps/> into your browser (good E reader.com). At the top of the page there will be a search box, search for "Libby." Tap on the orange "Download" button to download the app.

3: Install the Libby App

After the download is complete, tap Open > Install to install the Libby app.

4: Set Up the Libby App with Your Library Card

Launch the Libby app from the Fire Table/Kindle's carousel page and follow the prompts to find your library and add your library card(s) to the app.

Go back to Step #1 and disable the setting "Enable Apps from Unknown Sources."
