Mobile Wi-Fi Pilot Program

The Robert J. Kleberg Public Library is launching a pilot program that offers a mobile, high-speed, wireless Internet hotspot for patrons to checkout. The goal for the pilot Hotspot on the Go Checkout Program is to assess the community's need for this service. With a valid library card, a library patron signs a "Mobile Hotspot and Electronic Device Loan Agreement" and checks out a mobile Wi-Fi hotspot for three



weeks. For each checkout, the patron is assessed a non-refundable \$10.50 Technology User Fee to help offset any service

charges the library may incur during the pilot program. Then the user can access Sprint®'s wireless Internet connection. Devices that will be offered on a first come, first serve basis include mobile hotspots and tablets. For the mobile Wi-Fi hotspot, patrons can connect up to eight Wi-Fi ready devices. The library's pilot program will run approximately 30 days. If the pilot program is successful, the library will incorporate Hotspot on the Go into the library's Internet services.
