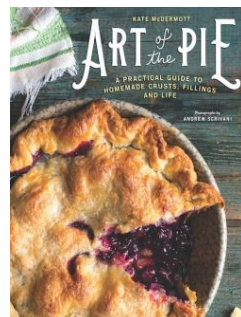
Sarita Library Card Registration Drive

Because of the underwriting of the Kenedy County Commissioners Court, the library will be hosting a *Library Card Registration Drive* in Sarita on March 16, 2017. From 12 noon – 4 p.m., library staff will be at the Kenedy County Courthouse to sign up residents for a new library card or to renew existing accounts. Everyone is encouraged to apply, and new applicants will receive a new library card during the drive. The first card is FREE and is valid for one year from the date of renewal or sign-up. With a library card, residents can access a myriad of services and resources. In addition to the registration drive, the *Library on the Go Bookmobile* staff will be on hand to educate residents about the library's digital services.



Big Library Read: *Art of the Pie*

The library will be hosting Big Library Read, a global eBook club, March 16-30, 2017. Big Library Read's latest selection is ***Art of the Pie*** by Kate McDermott. McDermott's book has been hailed as "one of 2016's best cookbooks and the pie-baking bible." Patrons who have a valid library card will have access to this title and can learn "her secrets to great crusts (including gluten-free options,) fabulous fillings, and to living a good life." *Art of the Pie* will be available for simultaneous use for community-wide access. At the end of the two-week lending period, the title is automatically removed from both the patron's device and Overdrive® account.
