Benefiting Driscoll Children's Hospital

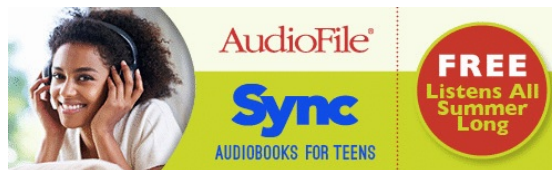
**Priyam Kumar (right, with brother Soaham) and
