Priyam Kumar (background, with brother Soaham) have collected more




than 200 new or gently used books from May 12 to June 9, 2018. Recently, the Kumar Family delivered the books to the Driscoll Children's Hospital.

Donations will be accepted through July 30, 2018. The drop-off site is the Robert J. Kleberg Public Library.


