Library Awarded E-Rate Discount Grant

Thank you to Mrs. Linda Miller, Library Technology Services, for securing \$9,800.00 in E-rate funding for the library. Because Internet usage has increased, the library will be upgrading Internet

access from 16 megabytes (MB) to 100 MB. The upgrade will increase the Internet download and streaming speeds. For the next five years,



Spectrum will have the contract to provide the Internet access, so the library can continue providing quality services to its patrons.

Innovations at the Library



To speed up the checkout process, the Technology Department has installed circulation receipt printers at each checkout station. Each receipt replaces

the due date stickers that were affixed to



each checked out item. Now, a patron receives a receipt with the following information: library address, phone number, web address, and date and time of checkout. In addition, each title is listed with its item ID number and due date. Patrons can also view their accounts

online by visiting the library's website, www.kleberglibrary.com, and clicking the "My Library" tab. For instructions to log in, select "How to Log in to Your Account." To log in directly, select "Your Account LOGIN Portal." With less time spent at checkout, staff members can spend more time assisting patrons.
