A patron's first library card is **FREE** for Kingsville and Kleberg County residents. After completing the brief application in person, a new patron will receive a library card within a few minutes. Residents are welcome to renew their expired library cards. The replacement fee for lost cards is \$3.00.



On Saturday, September 23, 2017, the library will host a book signing with Robert M. Villarreal, author of several works, from


10:30 a.m. to 12 noon. Mr. Villarreal wrote a five-volume series titled *Vaqueros: The Original Cowboys*, which chronicles the history of vaqueros from 1521 to the 20<sup>th</sup> century. Volume III: *Atanasia*, was turned into a full-length movie. The *Tejano Border Heroes* series records the role of Texas



Tejanos and Tejanas in the fight for justice from 1836 to 1915. In addition, Mr. Villarreal has written five stand-alone books. Copies of each book are \$10, and they will be available for purchase at the book signing. This event is free and open to the public.
