LIBRARY'S "OPENING OF TEXAS" STATEMENT

- In compliance with Kleberg County Judge Madrid's directive, all County facilities will continue to comply with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines.
- **FACE MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING will be required during your entire visit at the library.**
- The directive remains in effect until the County Judge modifies or rescinds the directive.
- Patrons no longer need to schedule an appointment to utilize library services.

COVID-19 RESPONSE

At the Robert J. Kleberg Public Library the safety and wellbeing of our patrons and staff is always a top priority. We continue to closely monitor the latest COVID-19 updates, and guidance from government and public health officials, so that we can implement appropriate preventative measures.

CLEANING PROTOCOLS

We wanted to share with you the cleaning protocols the library has implemented to foster a safe and hygienic environment.

- Clean N' Fresh® Instant Antibacterial Hand Sanitizer is provided to patrons and staff at various locations throughout the Library.
- Books will be cleaned with Lysol® Dual Action Wipes as well as Diversey™ End Bac® II Spray Disinfectant as they are returned to the Library, before they are shelved for circulation, and before they are checked out to patrons.
- The Bookstore collection will be periodically cleaned and disinfected with Diversey™ End Bac® II Spray Disinfectant.
- Staff has been instructed to periodically wash their hands for 20 seconds at a time throughout the day in accordance with the recommendation from the CDC.
- All tables and chairs in the Public Library will be cleaned and disinfected with Diversey™ Shine Up™ Furniture Cleaner throughout the day.
- All Restrooms in the Public Library will be cleaned and disinfected with Comet® Disinfecting Cleaner with Bleach, and Spartan® NABC® Non-Acid Disinfectant Bathroom Cleaner throughout the day.

Every County office in courthouse needs to be opened.

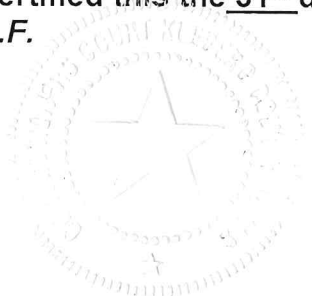
Anyone 18 and older can get the Moderna Vaccine at the JK Northway.
